

ASVAB Required Reporting 2022-2023 School Year

Introduction

This report fulfills Texas Education Agency (TEA) requirements of [Senate Bill \(SB\) 1843](#) (85th Texas Legislature, Regular Session, 2017). Specifically: "Not later than August 1 of each year, the agency shall publish a list of school districts and open-enrollment charter schools that elected under Subsection (d) or (e) not to provide the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery test during the previous school year."

Notes

1. The data included in this report were reported to the TEA through the 2022-2023 PEIMS fall data submission.
2. Districts and open-enrollment charter schools report the data in data element C217 (ARMED-SERVICES-VOC-APT-BATTERY-INDICATOR-CODE).¹
3. Districts and open-enrollment charter schools serving students in grades 10-12 that are not included in this report did not
