

# English Language Proficiency Standards Review Draft Recommendations

## Draft Recommendations, English Language Proficiency Standards Kindergarten-Grade 3 and Grades 4-2, Writing Domain

The proposed revisions to the English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS) for the writing domain in kindergarten through grade 3 and grades 4 through 2 are being reviewed. The document reflects recommendations for revisions to the standards that have been recommended by the State Board of Education's review work groups for the standards.

The proposed revisions for ELPS are divided into two grade bands: kindergarten–grade 3 and grades 4–2. Each domain has two sections: student expectations (SEs) and proficiency level descriptors (PLDs). SEs in the ELPS outline what emergent bilingual (EB) students should be able to do, and PLDs describe the specific PLDs in English language arts and reading, mathematics, science, and social studies.

Numbering for the standards in the document will be consistent with the Texas Register.

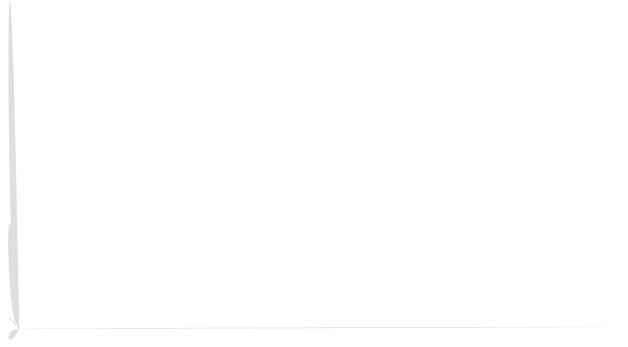

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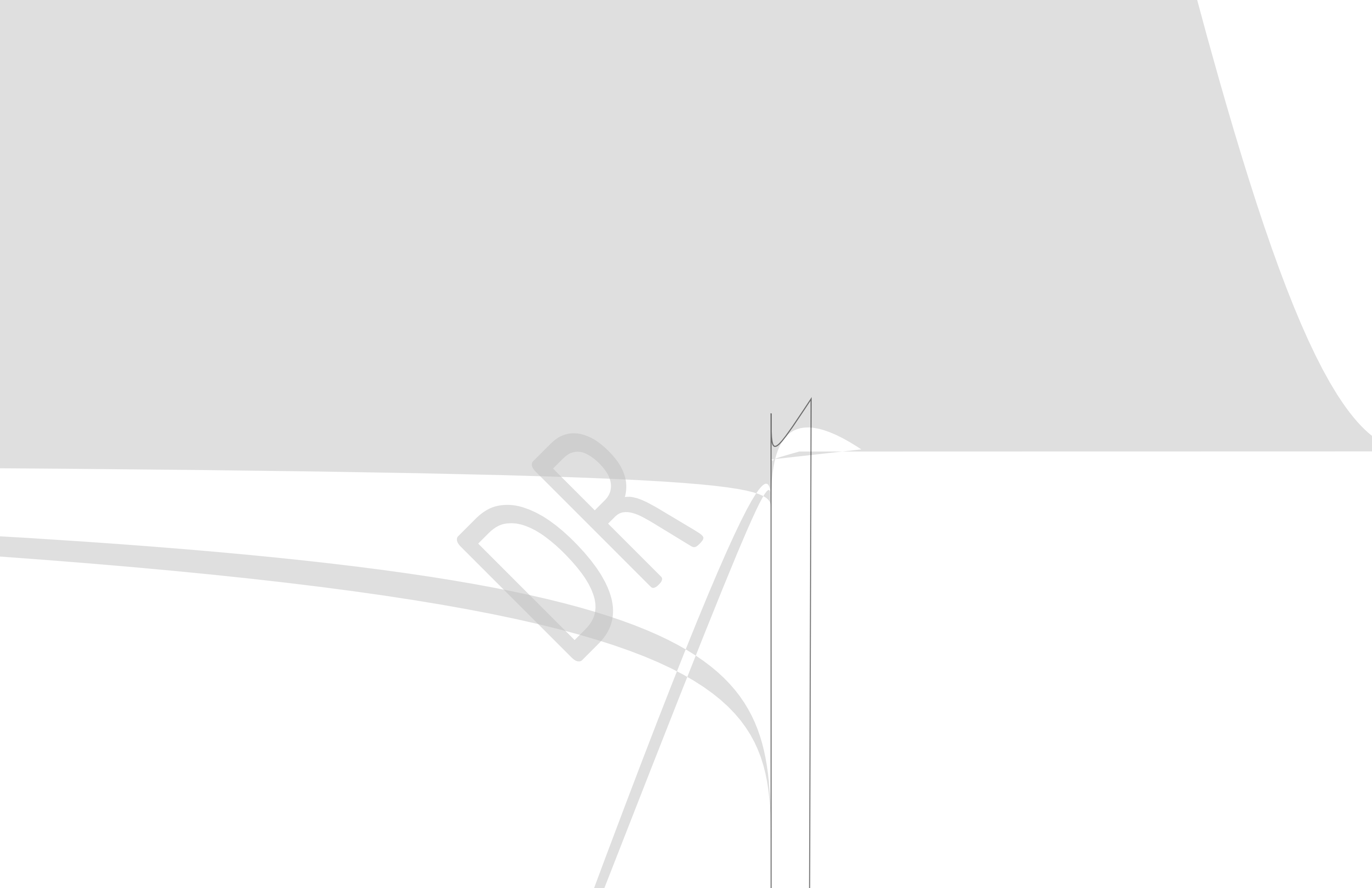






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
