LEAs that poly for a Beexception and/or an ESL waiver must develop a comprehensive professional development (PD) plan targeting the competencies needed to serve the needs of emergent bilingual students Furthermore, LEAs applying for a Beexception must assure that they will use a minimum of 10% of their BEAllotment (BEA) funds for PD provided through the comprehension plan.
