

(1) if a student graduated in any cohort year, the student's final status was graduate; and (2) if a student dropped out of the last district he or she attended but also earned a TxCHSE by August 31, 2022, the final status was TxCHSE recipient (see Table 4 for examples of how final statuses are determined).

About the Campus of Accountability (COA). For accountability and reporting purposes, students are attributed to the campus where their COA is determined by TEA. This occurs when students attend multiple campuses within a district (and at least one is not a Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP) or Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP) campus). The student is attributed to the last non-DAEP, non-JJAEP campus of attendance based on PEIMS attendance records reported for the prior year or enrollment records reported the following fall for continuers.
