# x Educator Certification and Preparation

- o Several updates to the Guidance on Educator Certification and Preparation FAQ were posted.
  - f Governor Abbott issued waivers allowing those candidates completing student teaching or an internship this spring to receive a one-year, probationary certificate for the 2020-21 school year without taking certification exams if they have met all other certification requirements.
- o <u>Instructions for teacher candidates</u> applying for a probationary certificate were posted.
- o For Educator Preparation Programs, <u>instructions</u> were posted for recommending a probationary certificate for a teacher candidate.

# x Attendance and Enrollment

- A clarification on the sixth-six weeks reporting period related to the 2019-2020 PEIMS Summer Submission was included in an updated <u>Attendance and Enrollment FAQ</u>.
- x Uncontactable &/or Disengaged Students
  - o A new FAQ and Best Practices guidance was posted related to supporting districts with identifying <u>Uncontactable Students</u>.
