



NOGA tentative date

December 1, 2021



By October 29, complete eGrant for Decision 4.

Review and accept your award amount for the following:

4A – paraprofessional certification and education pathway

\$8,000 per certification-only candidate



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FAQ #1

As written in the Program Guidelines:

Bullet point 3 on the Pre-Requisites for stipend reads, "Candidates must have the capacity to graduate with a bachelor's degree and teacher certification within the timeline of the grant." Does this mean that candidates who have completed their bachelor's degree but need to alt are disqualified.

GYO Response

No, the \$8,000 stipend is for these candidates. This prerequisite should read "Candidates must have the capacity to graduate with a bachelor's degree and/or teacher certification within the timeline of the grant."







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


Grow Your Own: Grant Implementation Timeline


General Requirements (see pg. 48 for complete list)

Ensure candidates meet these requirements

Sign MOU between LEA and candidates

Submit quarterly reports on performance measures (e.g., names of participating candidates, number of students enrolled)

Submit candidate info by March 1, 2022





Grow Your Own: Requirements (pg. 47)

Review Scheduling & MOU process

4a: Paraprofessional Certification


Bachelor's degree and certification must be completed within 2 years (teacher of record in the 2024–2025 school year)

Certification only candidates enroll in same Ed. Prep. Program

MOU between LEA and EPP partner

Paid release time and schedule flexibility for class attendance and completion of course requirements

6 candidates max per LEA





Grow Your Own: Requirements (pg. 47)

4b and 4c: Education & Training

Offer Instructional Practices and/or Practicum in 2022–23 and both in 2023–2024 at ALL high schools

Dual-credit stipend recipients need to be teacher of record

Establish and/or grow **CTSO** (TAFE or FCCLA)



GYO Response

The intention behind this program assurance is that we are not leaving any students out from having the opportunity to pursue a career in education. 









